This position is at the L08 level with an hourly pay range of \$29.73 to \$37.62.

Reporting to the Laboratory Manager, the incumbent provides support to physicians/healthcare provider through the collection and analysis of clinical specimens, in identifying the cause of certain symptoms in patients or the presence of certain conditions in patients maintains an on-going quality control program in order to ensure the accuracy and quality of the test results; keep accurate records of all procedures; calculates and records statistics; performs other duties.

Knowledge and Skills required for this position are as follows:

- Excellent organizational and analytical skills;
- Knowledge of medical laboratory principles, theories, procedures, methods, techniques and practices;
- Knowledge and ability to maintain a wide variety of complex laboratory equipment with and without the aid of service personnel;
- Ability to perform routine and special analysis/procedures;
- Ability to proficiently perform phlebotomies;
- Ability to maintain records and prepare comprehensive and concise reports;
- Ability to operate a computer and experience in utilizing a Laboratory Information System;
- Ability to deal with interruptions, distractions, time pressures, concurrent demands and client pressures;
- Ability to choose one method, technique or practice over another as situation warrants;
- Ability to work independently;
- Ability to pay strong attention to detail;
- Excellent problem solving and decision making skills;
- Effective interpersonal skills including discretion, tact and reliability; and
- Cross-cultural awareness.

Candidates must be certified as a Registered Laboratory Technologist in Canada and be a member in good standing with the Canadian Society for Medical Laboratory Science. Recent experience working in an accredited medical Laboratory, WHIMIS certification and a valid class 5 driver's license are also required for this position. This position will be expected to work all shifts and perform on-call duties as required.

A degree in Laboratory medicine, advanced Registered Technologist Certification from CSMLS, non-violent crisis intervention, leadership training, CPR certification and bilingualism would be considerable assets for this position.
