Reporting directly to the Health Service Administrator and indirectly to the Medical Director on clinical matters; indirectly to the Regional Director, Diagnostic Services on capital planning, standardization, quality, and benchmarking. The Chief Technologist is responsible for organizing, managing and controlling all aspects of the Laboratory operation at Prince Rupert Regional Hospital, Queen Charlotte City Hospital and Northern Haida Gwaii Hospital, by supervising laboratory work, by providing a communication link with health care professionals and by assuring adequate staffing. Also performs diagnostic testing in biochemistry, hematology, blood bank, urology and microbiology as required.

To be qualified in this position you will have obtained membership of the Canadian Society of Laboratory Technologists as a registered Medical Technologist at the Advanced Registered Technologist (ART) level or equivalent Baccalaureate (B.M.L.Sc.) degree preferred. You will also have 5 years post Registered Technologist (RT) experience including two years related supervisory experience, or an equivalent combination of training, management experience and education acceptable to the hospital.
