

BCSLS Congress 2012 Trade Show

Dear BCSLS Supporter:

Please review the Exhibitor Prospectus for the Trade Show to be held during the BCSLS Congress 2012 in Kamloops, B.C., from Sept 27-29th.

This is your opportunity to “**Examine the past, explore the present and embrace the future**” and join us for the BCSLS Congress 2012 in Kamloops, BC on September 27, 28 and 29, 2012. The Congress will be held in the Campus Activity Center at Thompson Rivers University [TRU] in Kamloops. The central location in the province assures a record number of delegates.

The Exhibit Space is in the Grand Hall and the adjacent Rotunda of the Campus Activity Center, 7800 square feet in all. The exhibit area is in the same part of the complex as the workshop breakout rooms and plenary hall. An outside courtyard / square at the entrance to the center will accommodate at least 4 truck / trailers with portable displays and these outdoor exhibits will be very visible to delegates.

Foot traffic through the trade show will be ensured by having all the catering for refreshments and lunch breaks set up in the exhibit area. A value added benefit will be that vendor representatives will have early access to refreshments and meals allowing them to talk to clients during break periods. Coffee will be served during set-up. The Exhibitors Reception will kick off the trade show on the Thursday evening.

The exhibit hall can be easily accessed through large doors off a driveway at the rear of the Grand Hall, so set up will be a snap.

The trade show facilities at Congress 2012 will provide for mostly 8' X10' booths with some 6' X 10' and 4' X 10' booths in the Rotunda. Booth prices will reflect booth size. Registration will be on a first come first served basis. Congress sponsors will be given preference for booth size and location. **There will be two premium 8' X 10' booths on the landing of the Rotunda, with guaranteed optimum traffic flow.**

The BCSLS values your continued support, but we do ask that during scheduled Congress hours you do not offer competing commercial, educational or social events.

When registering, please provide your corporate information and agree to the Terms and Conditions outlined in this prospectus. This agreement will execute the contract as of that date.

Please indicate if you are interested in becoming a sponsor of Congress 2012. Official 2012 sponsors will be allocated preferential booth locations at Congress. Booth allocations will be finalized in August.
