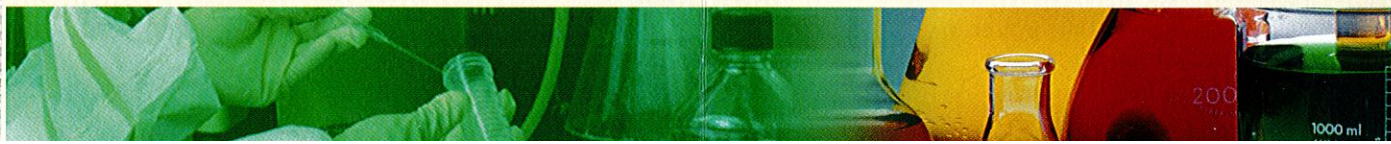

- **Scientific Conference(s)** – one-day theme conferences such as Crime Scene (forensic sciences), toxicology, microbiology, clinical genetics and others.

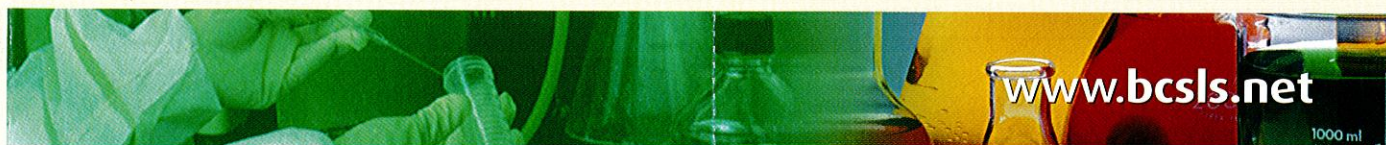
- **Self-Study Courses** – Back to Basics Refresher (Chemistry & Hematology), Virology, FISH and others.
